Habitat

- Open or semi-open areas along habitat edges
- Seedlings compete poorly with more aggressive species
- Thrive best in full sun or partial shade
 - Along streams in floodplains
 - Openings in wooded canopy
 - Disturbed sites
 - Along roadsides sometimes used as a windbreak

Productive Use of Marginal Land

- Second soils sunny slope, rocky, sandy
- Soil retention erosion & run-off control
- On berms in low wet areas, along ponds
- Forest / field borders, windbreaks, irregular islands or contours
